

3rd AUROVILLE FILM FESTIVAL 2013

Welcome to the Auroville Film Festival '13! The aim of this festival is to connect with people and cultures within and beyond Auroville and to further the aspiration of Human Unity by showcasing films that develop this theme. We feature films that are created in and around Auroville, as well as international films. This third time around, the biennial Auroville Film Festival is only bigger and better. The festival will show 125 films over six days from September 17th to September 22nd at three venues: **Cinema Paradiso**, **Town Hall Conference Room**, and **Outside the Town Hall**. This year, as before, the categories are:

1. films made by residents of Auroville and the bio-region;
2. films made about Auroville and the bio-region;
3. films made by school students residing in Auroville and its bio-region;
4. films that develop the theme of Human Unity.

Musical Performances: organized by Anungla, they will feature Aloé & Tara, Anna & Rolf, Pushkar & Pinco, Rolf & François, Suryan, Joska and herself, as well as poetry readings. These will be every evening from 5.30pm - 7.30pm at the shamiana.

Yummy Food: Between 5pm and 9pm, enjoy goodies served up by Dreamers Café, Tamarind Bakery, Poorani, Pour Tous Distribution Centre, G P Corner Café, Monika, Sadhana Forest, Youth Centre, Liliana, and others at the shamiana.

Photograph Exhibition: Curated by Daljeet Wadhwa and presented by the Sri Aurobindo School of Arts & Communication, New Delhi, these photographs by Kartik are selected with the theme of human unity in mind from his series called 'Lines of Faith'.

Poster Exhibition: These posters, exhibited around the Town Hall, are by Miguel Silva, Marie, Marco and the filmmakers from Auroville and the bio-region.

Art Installations: Discover the installations created by Ok, Auroson, Renu, Marc, Sasi and Naushad especially for this festival.
